



**Athina Tatsioni, MD** graduated from the University of Ioannina Medical School. She is a Board Certified Physician in General Practice /Family Medicine since 2003. Dr Tatsioni completed her PhD Thesis, an individual patient data meta-analysis, in the Department of Hygiene and Epidemiology in the University of Ioannina Medical School. She worked at Tufts Evidence-based Practice Center (EPC) in Boston Massachusetts in USA as a research associate for two years (2003-2005). She is Assistant Professor of Medicine (adjunct) at Tufts University School of Medicine since 2005. She worked as a Lecturer, General Medicine, in the University of Ioannina Medical School (2009-13). Since May 2013 she has been appointed as Assistant Professor, General Medicine, in the University of Ioannina Medical School. She has co-authored systematic reviews and meta-analyses on a broad range of clinical subjects and methodological issues, which have been published in peer-reviewed journals. Her research interests include quality assessment of intervention and diagnostic studies, comparative effectiveness research, evidence based clinical decision in primary care. Currently, Dr Tatsioni has 47 publications in Medline, which have received more than 1000 citations, and h-index 16. Since 2010, she is Coordinating Editor for the European Journal of Clinical Investigation and Statistical Advisor in the Editorial Board for Annals of Gastroenterology.
